If you are an older person who is being harmed by the actions of someone else, such as a family member, friend, neighbour or carer, you may be experiencing elder abuse.

Legal Aid WA provides free, confidential legal help to prevent elder abuse and safeguard the rights of older Western Australians.

We can advise you about:

- planning for the future (Enduring Powers of Attorney, Enduring Powers of Guardianship and Advance Health Directives)
- misuse of an Enduring Power of Attorney
- providing legal assistance when someone lacks decision making capacity (guardianship and administration)
- granny flats and moving in with family
- family law and issues involving grandchildren
- protection from violence or abuse
- referrals to community and government agencies
