CREATE CONTENT

If you create a text message, video message, photo, email or other communication while driving you can be fined \$1000 and lose 4 demerit points. Even if the phone is secured in a mounting or can be operated without touching it.



SEND CONTENT

If you send a text message, video message, photo, email or other communication while driving you can be fined \$1000 and lose 4 demerit points. Even if the phone is secured in a mounting or can be operated without touching it.



LOOK AT CONTENT

If you look at a text message, video message, photo, email or other communication while driving you can be fined \$1000 and lose 4 demerit points. Even if the phone is secured in a mounting or can be operated without touching it.



USE NAVIGATION APPS

If you touch a phone while driving to change the function of a navigational app (even if it is secured in a mounting) you can be fined \$1000 and lose 4 demerit points. You can only use a navigational app while driving if the phone is placed in a secured mounting and the route is set and started before you start driving.



MAKE/RECEIVE A CALL

If you touch a phone that is not secured to a mounting to make or receive an audio call while driving, you can be fined \$500 and lose 3 demerit points. You can receive or terminate an audio call while driving if you are using a hands free connection and you do not touch the phone.
